## 2. READING COMPREHENSION (3 Puntos)

Springfield College of Further Education offers four First Aid courses aimed at different types of students. Read the information about the courses below.

	What's On The Course?	What Are The Entry Requirements?
<b>A</b>	This course is designed to provide basic first aid training for staff in businesses, where a risk assessment has indicated that a lower level of first aid cover is sufficient. The course entitles successful attendees to gain an accredited first aid certificate.	Business assessed as only requiring certification for Emergency First Aid At Work.
<b>B</b>	This course updates the first aid skills for people who need to renew their statutory First Aid at Work certificate, and whose existing certificate is still valid.  This course refreshes the knowledge required by the first-aider and will provide any updates to that knowledge. There will also be time provided for revision and practical skills refreshing, so that students are prepared for their final assessment.  There will be an end of course Practical Examination. Successful students will renew their certificate in First Aid approved by the Health & Safety Executive.	You must already hold a valid certificate for First Aid at Work, which has not expired more than 28 days prior to the course. The course must be completed no later than 28 days after the expiry of the previous certificate.
<b>C</b>	This course provides qualified first-aiders with an opportunity to practice and update skills at any time during the three year period which certification covers.  The three hour session will build on the expertise and confidence you already have by simulating realistic situations and casualties. You will be able to practise your first aid skills in hands-on, practical sessions.	Be a current holder of certification in First Aid at Work or Emergency First Aid at Work.
<b>D</b>	This course is designed for staff accompanying students and other groups on excursions and field study trips where various risks have been identified. Certification is valid only for the above mentioned travelling activities.	None.
